Title: LEAP

Description: This program prepares at-risk rising 6th graders for the transition from elementary to middle school. LEAP is designed to give students a head start socially and academically.

Location: All Middle Schools

Number of Participants: (BMS – 40, DMS – 95, ELW – 50, KMMS – 40, LMS – 34, SPMS – 37)

Duration: Two Weeks

Title: Summer School

Description: Summer school provides academic support for students who have failed one or two core content classes in the middle school.

Location: All Middle Schools

Number of Participants: (BMS – 59, DMS – 177, ELW – 110, KMMS – 34, LMS – 79, SPMS – 88)

Duration: Two Weeks

Title: Jumpstart!

Description: This camp for rising 6th graders is designed to assist the transition from elementary to middle school.

Location: Blythewood Middle School

Number of Participants: 169

Duration: July 21 –July 24, 8am – 12noon

Title: GEAR UP Camp Algebra

Description: This camp is designed to introduce students to specific algebraic concepts covered during the school year. It is designed for rising ninth grade students who may be enrolled in Algebra I for the 2010-2011 school year.

Location: Blythewood Middle School

Number of participants: 15 (by invitation only)

Duration: One week – June 15-22 or June 23-30

Cost: None

Title: BMS Future City Summer Camp

Description: This camp is designed to encourage interest in the Future City Team. Students will learn about futuristic technologies, play SimCity 4, and learn the role of an engineer.

Location: Blythewood Middle School

Number of participants: Unlimited

Duration: Three days (June 22nd, 23rd, 24th)
