### *Fall 2010*

\*30 students participate in Round Top's Student Council. These are the students that are responsible for the majority of the school's recycling. Each StuCo. Representative is responsible for their own homeroom and are also assigned a lower grade classroom or faculty office to be responsible for.

\*Each classroom/office has a small recycling bin. Each StuCo. Rep. empties the small bin into the larger roll bins once a week. Service Solutions aids our recycling efforts by moving the large bins curbside and then bringing them back in each week. StuCo. Reps are allowed to recycle any day of the week that is acceptable with their teacher, with the exception of Wednesday since this is pick-up day and the bins are outside.

\*Gloves are kept in the Media Center for the students to pick up and use each day that they recycle. There is also a chart that they sign-off on – this helps with accountability. Although, I will say the teachers do a good job of letting me know when their bins are overflowing. ☺

\*StuCo. Reps. are also responsible for the education of acceptable recycling material. They request class time from each teacher that they are responsible for, to go over "good" and "bad" material. Peer to peer interaction really seems to help our recycling efforts.

\*Spring Goal – to reduce amount of recycling that needs to be done by educating our school on what can be reused and then encouraging them to do so!

### *Educational Components*

\*Dave Hart spoke to Student Council on importance of recycling. He also walked them through sorting procedures. This empowered the StuCo. Reps. to be able to speak knowledgeably with their peers and pass on valuable information.

\*"Recyclops" visited our morning news program and educated students on the value of recycling. He "chastised" one of our good natured assistant principals for throwing away items that could be recycled.

\*5<sup>th</sup> grade students were visited by a DHEC representative who also spoke about the value of "Reducing, Reusing and Recycling!"

### *Action Components*

Student Council representatives recycle their classrooms once a week. They educate and encourage peers to recycle responsibly.

Students are continually educated on the value of recycling so they get a grasp of the “bigger picture” and what a difference even doing small things can make.
