DISTRICT EXPECTATIONS FOR 2016-17

Short Term Expectations:

- Partner with Martha Jones and Abby Cobb to continue enhancing and expanding the Summer Food Service Program by adding additional food truck sites.
- Upon hiring a dietitian, meet with the Elementary Science/Health and PE Coordinator (Ed Emmer) to develop a classroom nutrition segment.
- Hold quarterly finance meetings with Shelley Allen and her accountants to review the food service financial account.
- Jack will work with the district technology department to allow Kronos Time Clocks installation in all school kitchens.

Long Term Expectations:

- Continue to develop innovative methods to increase elementary school lunch participation.
- Work with R2i2 Event Coordinator to expand catering program.
- Collaborate with the R2i2 Instructors to offer culinary training.
- Open retail kiosk at R2i2.
