This rigorous program for students in grades 6-12 is designed to meet the individual needs of students by providing personalized learning pathways in an online setting. Students in this program demonstrate mastery of South Carolina Department of Education standards and district expectations for learning.

Profile of a Richland Two eSchool Student

- Ability to attend and engage in synchronous online learning daily as scheduled.
- Enjoys being an independent, self-directed learner with support from a teacher facilitator.
- Exhibits the ability to persevere and not give up easily when learning.

Enrollment Criteria

Students in Richland Two's eSchool Program must meet the following enrollment criteria.

- Must be rising 6th-12th grade student zoned for a middle or high school in Richland Two
- Must hold a positive attendance record during the most recent school term
- Must have demonstrated positive academic performance during the most recent school term
- Positive teacher recommendation

Program Requirements

Parents are required to ensure that students meet the following requirements.

- Attend synchronous sessions as required (SDE Attendance Requirements are followed)
- Reliable internet access
- Ability to transport students to required in-person sessions, including school, district and state testing and field studies
- Provide supplies needed for hands-on activities from home

Richland Two's eSchool Program provides a number of benefits to students, parents and our community.

- We provide live instruction in real-time to support student learning.
- Our program follows Richland Two and South Carolina Department of Education curriculum requirements.
- Students are provided remediation through Individual Learning Time (ILT) and tutoring.
- Honors classes are offered at the middle and high school levels.
- Students may take career-related classes (in-person and virtually) at Richland Two's Institute for Innovation (R2i2).
- High school students may take asynchronous classes to provide flexibility in scheduling.
- Our students may participate in extra-curricular activities at their zoned/assigned school.
- Students may participate in field studies and other activities to enhance their learning.
- We employ South Carolina certified teachers who are trained to support online learners.
- Our students graduate with a South Carolina High School diploma with their peers from their zoned high school.
